



## **Tour of area War of 1812 sites offered**

On June 22, the Maryland War of 1812 Bicentennial Commission will conduct a tour of several sites related to the 1814 British invasion of North Point. The tour is intended to inform people associated with other War of 1812 sites in the state and region in preparation for the upcoming war bicentennial and is open to the public as space is available.

The event is set to begin at North Point State Park at 9:30 a.m. with an introduction of the Baltimore County War of 1812 Bicentennial Advisory Committee.

The tour will include the British landing site at Fort Howard, the Todd's Inheritance house, the Aquila Randall Monument, Battle Acre, North Point Battlefield and the site of the Methodist Meeting House.
